Children

Where Youth Fit In

If you are the Christian parent of a 7th-12th grader, we think of you being the primary discipler of your child. Consequently, we want to come alongside you in your discipling. We encourage 7th-12th grade students to attend *Life Courses* with their parents, when possible. Also, we consider the public services of the church to be our main ministry to students.

Youth provide a unique and energetic texture to the life of our church. Our church wants to provide students with opportunities to grow in their understanding and love for Jesus and the Gospel.

Youth Ministry

Our youth ministry is not merely an extension of the church; rather it is a means to fold youth into the life of our congregation. We seek to do this by encouraging youth to participate in things such as local, national, and foreign mission trips and projects.

We also hope to begin monthly meetings for Biblical teaching, recreation and fellowship as our church grows.
